A positive feed margin can only be realized with high mass gains and a relatively low cost of feed.

## **Planning Requirements For Feedlots | Handling and ...**

The overall layout of a feedlot will depend on site selection, expansion plans, and the choice of feeding, watering, cattle moving and waste handling systems. The slope of the site is the main factor affecting drainage patterns and therefore pen locations relative to feeding alleys and pen drains. Most feedlots follow a rectangular layout with multiple feeding pens.

The USDA Feeder Cattle Grading System or any other system you use is a method of sorting cattle. Ideally, cattle should be sorted into similar types and sizes for a uniform nutrition program for all the animals in a pen. A certain amount of sorting may still need to be done when cattle arrive at the feedlot.
