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Density Of Aqueous Ammonia Solutions

Ammonia solutions decrease in density as the concentration of dissolved ammonia increases. At 15.6 °C (60.1 °F), the density of a saturated solution is 0.88 g/ml and contains 35.6% ammonia by mass, 308 grams of ammonia per litre of solution, and has a molarity of approximately 18 mol /L.

Ammonia solutions The alkali metals dissolve slowly in liquid ammonia , forming ammoniacal solutions of solvated metal cation M^+ and solvated electron e^- , which react to form hydrogen gas and the alkali metal amide (MNH_2 , where M represents an alkali metal): this was first noted by Humphry Davy in 1809 and rediscovered by W. The ammonia solution (NH_3) of 25% means 25 gr NH_3 in 100 ml
