Caetano v. Massachusetts, 577 US __, 136 S. Ct. 1027(2016). The US Supreme Court held that the reasoning of the SJC in Comm. v. Caetano, 470 Mass. 774 (2015), in ruling that the Second Amendment didn't apply to stun guns was incorrect. The US Supreme Court sent the case back to Massachusetts. The case didn't rule the Massachusetts law, MGL c. 140, § 131J, unconstitutional.
