Le Corbusier projects the Unité de Berlin Modulator the system had the form of 2.26m and in the Unite d'habitation of Marseille, however the difficult relations with employees and the incompatibility of building regulations in Germany were forced to abandon the proportions given by the Modulator and increase one meter in height between the floors.
